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## Student Responsibilities

## Texas Success Initiative

For 2025, UNT will admit dual credit students in accordance with the Texas definition of a non-degree-seeking student. In accordance with Texas Administrative Code Title 19, Part I, Chapter 4, Subchapter C, a dual credit student completing 15 semester credit hours or more must file a degree plan and meet Texas Success Initiative (TSI) requirements for college readiness in reading, writing and mathematical skills prior to enrolling in additional college-level credit at Texas public institutions. College readiness is demonstrated through a Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board approved assessment or exemption. ## Turnitin User Agreement

In taking UNT Dual Credit courses, students may be required to submit written homework assignments through a secure, web-based service known as Turnitin. Turnitin's formative feedback and originality checking services promote critical thinking, ensure academic integrity, and help students improve their practices for using and citing other people's written material and to provide students feedback electronically. Turnitin's User agreement requires parental permission for students between the ages of 14 to 17 to use this service. By signing this approval form, you acknowledge that you have reviewed and understand the Turnitin User Agreement (<https://turnitin.com/agreement.asp>) and that you give permission for your child to use the Turnitin service. Once signed, this agreement will apply to all subsequent semesters unless the agreement is withdrawn in writing by the parent/guardian.
