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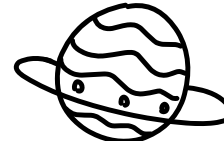

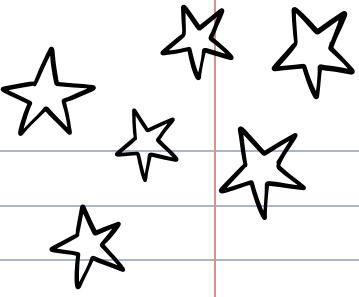


Super Fair: 1:30-3 p.m.
